PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

- ✓ The Tourism Scholarship Programme supports education and training in tourism, culture, antiquities and transportation.
- ✓ The Programme is administered by Department of Advanced Training and Advisory Services, (DATAS), under the Division of Education, Research and Technology (DERTech).
- ✓ It targets Tobagonians resident in Tobago for at least three years.
- ✓ Funding supports tertiary studies, professional certification and short courses.
- ✓ The Programme honours Tobagonians who made lasting contributions to tourism and culture.





TOURISM SCHOLARSHIP *Programme*

SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES

Full Scholarship:

The George Stanley Beard Scholarship for studies in either Cultural/Heritage Tourism or Macro/Large-Scale Festival Management.

Covers 100% of tuition fees, living expenses (capped), books and materials for full-time students. Annually, one (1) full scholarship may be awarded to one (1) individual who qualifies.





TOURISM SCHOLARSHIP *Programme*

SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORIES

Partial Scholarship:

- **The Rawle “Axeback” Titus Scholarship** for studies in either the **Creative Arts or Cultural Entrepreneurship/Management**;
- **The Edward Hernandez Scholarship** for studies in either **Museum Studies and Archival Studies or Archaeology**.
- **The Anacle George Scholarship** for studies in **Sustainable Tourism Development/Management**
- **The Kay Alleyne Scholarship** for studies in the **Performing Arts or Cultural Entrepreneurship**
- **The Leeandro Noray Scholarship** for studies in **Music Production, Creative/Fine Arts (Music/Film), Steelpan Certification/APA Steelpan Fellowship at the University of Trinidad and Tobago**.

Covers up to 100% of tuition fees and books for both full-time and part-time students. Annually, one (1) scholarship in each category may be awarded to an individual who qualifies.

Provides up to 100% tuition for short-term certification programmes.
